

HOW TO FIND A JP

In Queensland there are two types of JPs:

Commissioner for Declaration (C.Dec) or Justice of the Peace (C.Dec)

- to witness signatures on a document

Justice of the Peace (Qualified)

- to witness signatures on a document
- to issue a search warrant
- to remand defendants
- to adjourn a court
- to grant bail

Justice of the Peace (Magistrates Court)

- to perform all the duties of a C.Dec and JP (Qual)
- to also constitute a court to conduct committal proceedings and
- to hear simple offences or certain indictable offences where there is a guilty plea
